Coffee Meet with Parents



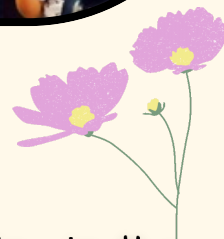

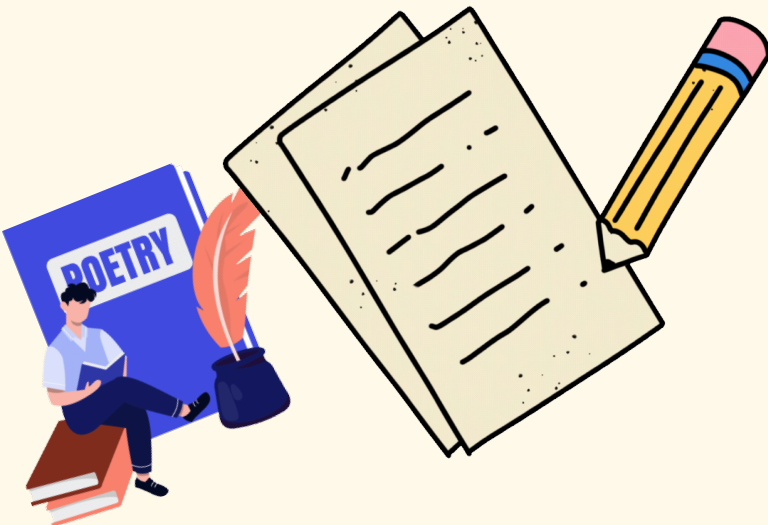
Literary Fest

Grade 1- Aesthetic Learning Embracing Nature's Beauty:

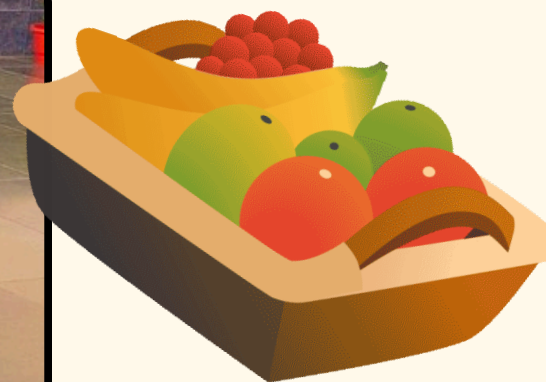
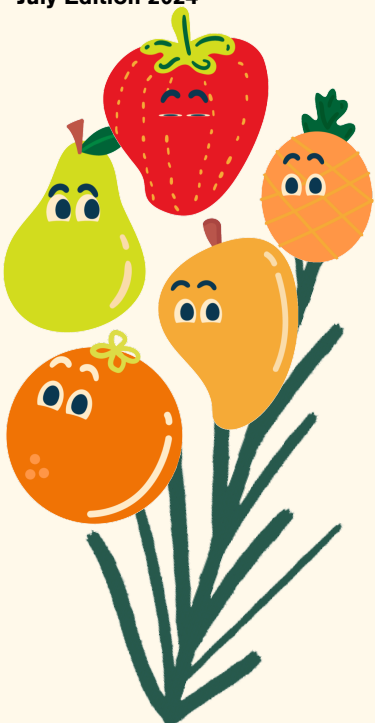

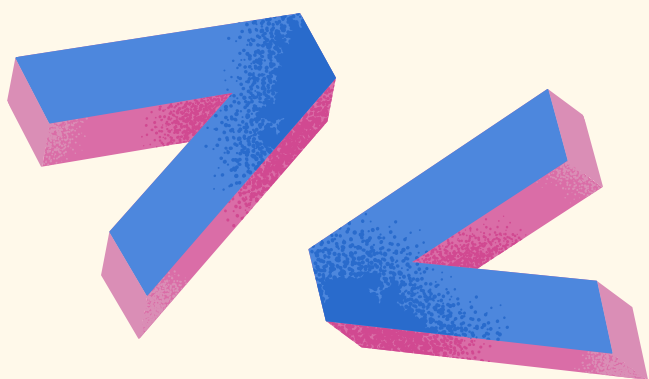
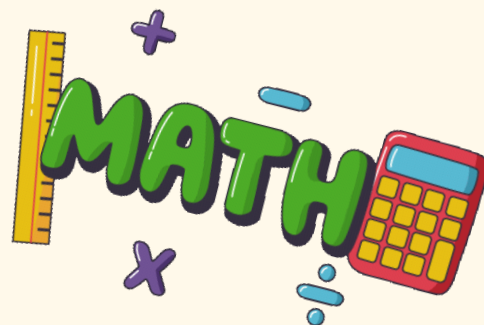
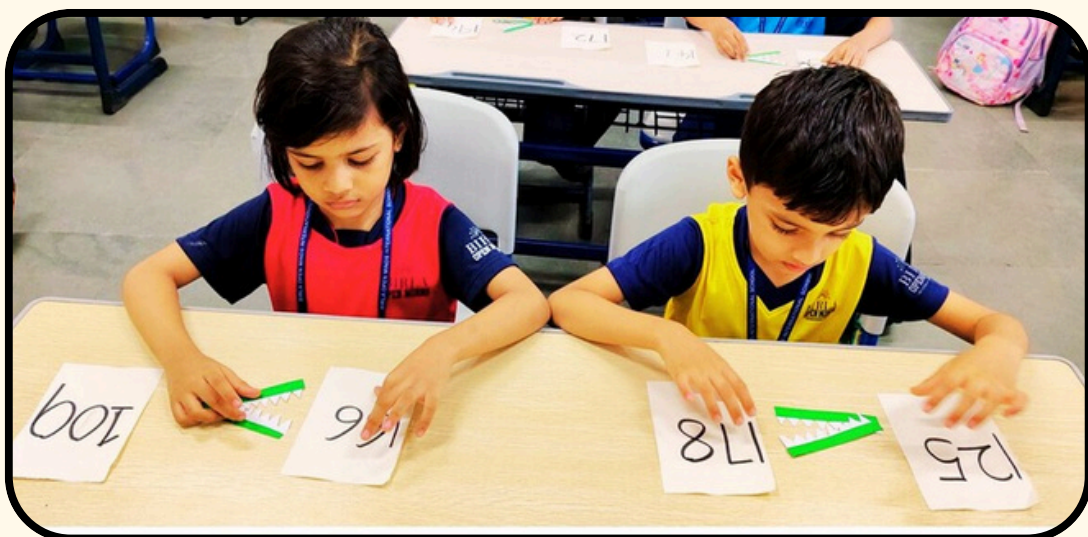






Spotlight on Math Activities

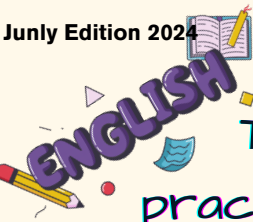
Act it Out



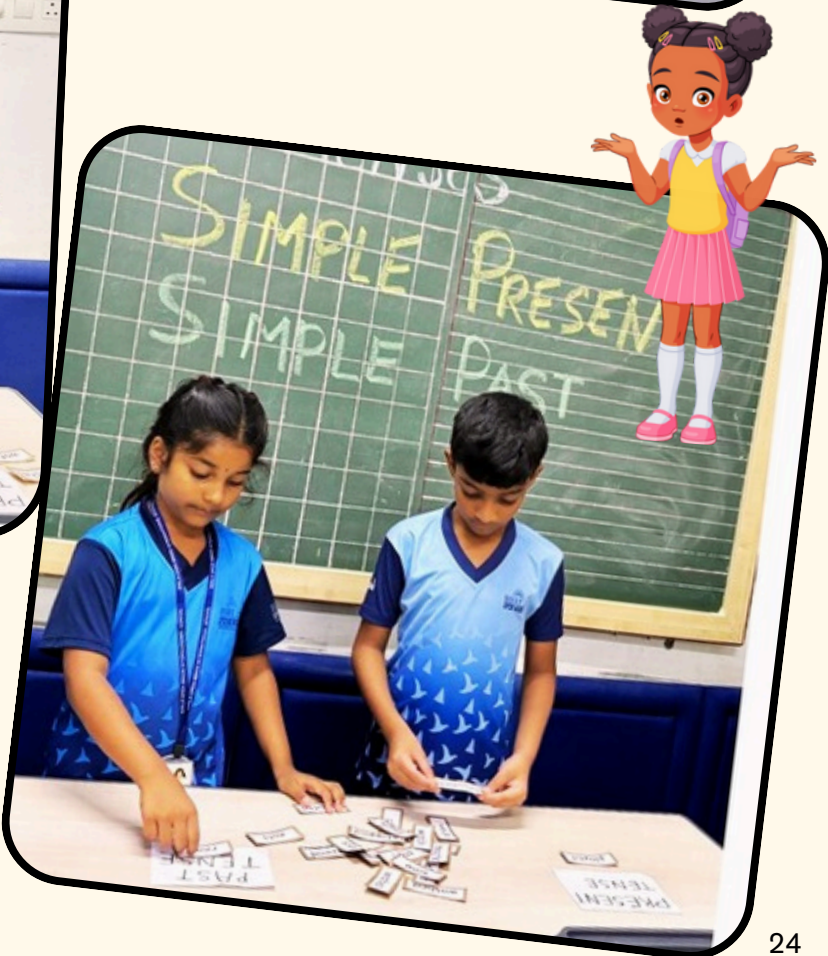
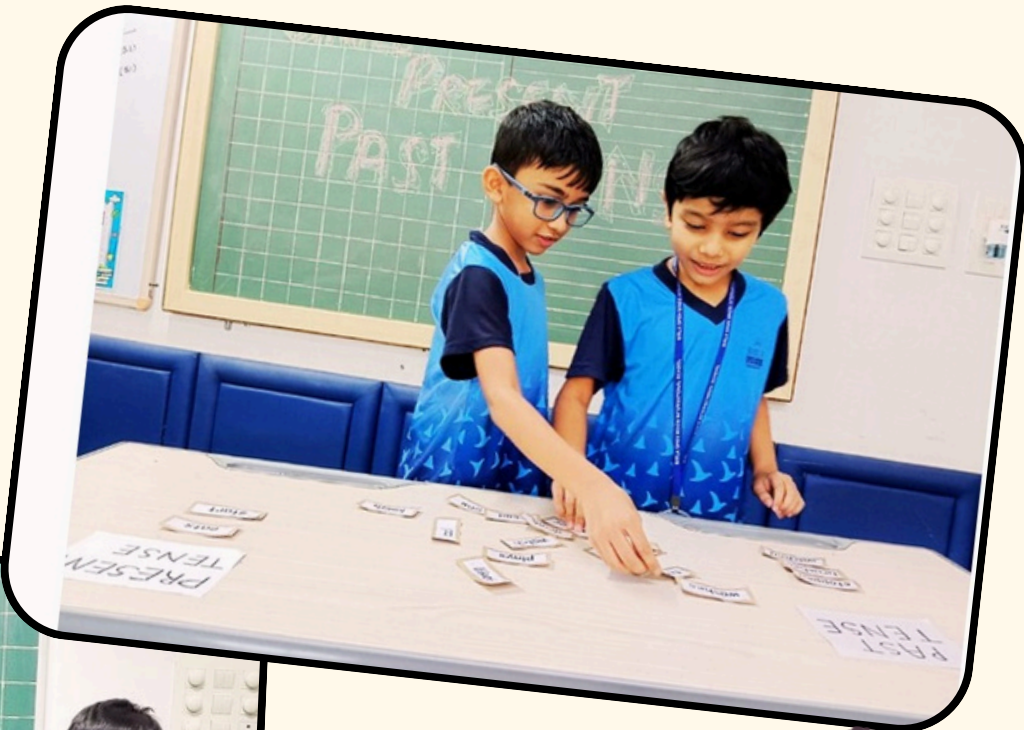

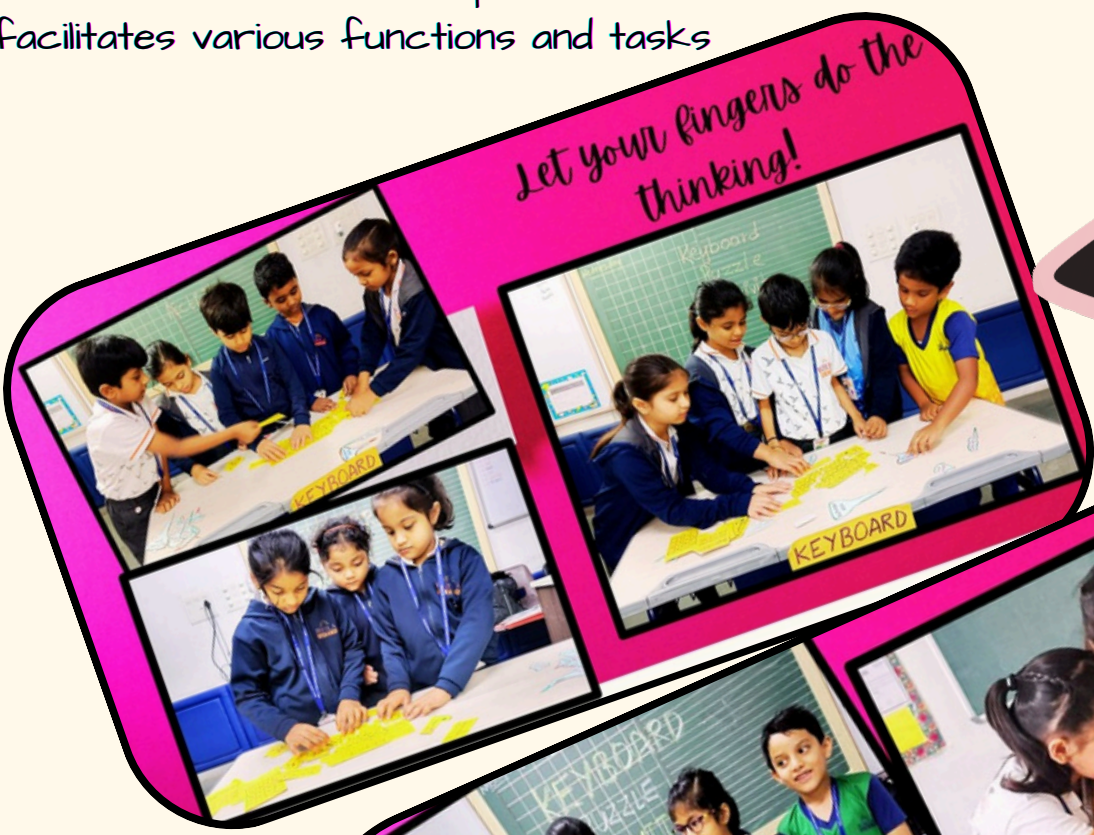


"The power of technology is incredible. Technology combined with education can change the world."

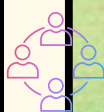
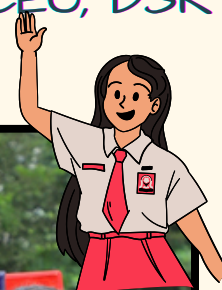
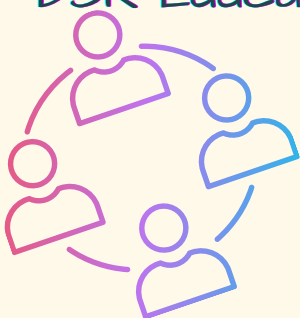
INVESTITURE CEREMONY
