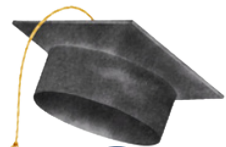

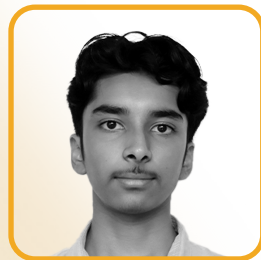

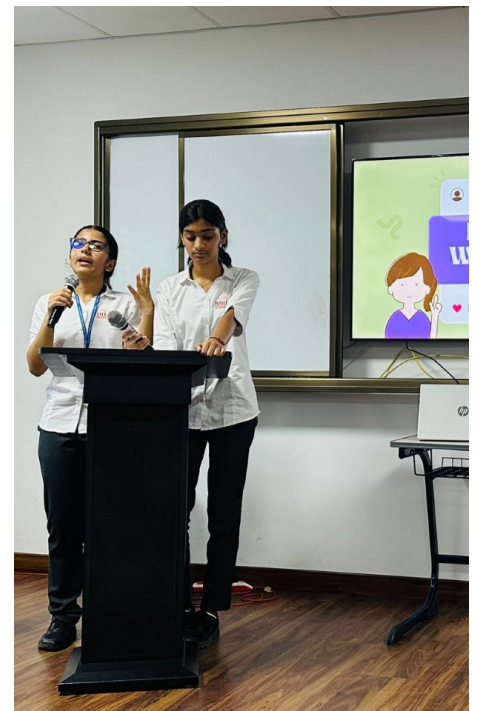
SAFETY WEEK

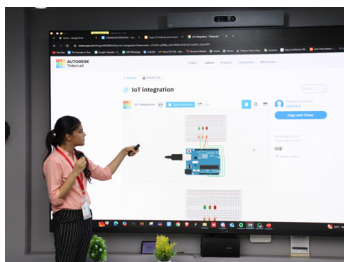


HANDS-ON INTERNSHIPS
